
Dear Mr. Hall:

Yankee Atomic Electric Company (YAEC) is pleased to submit the enclosed Corrective Action Design and application for a Beneficial Use Determination (BUD) for the Southeast Construction Fill Area (SCFA) at the Yankee Nuclear Power Station (YNPS) in Rowe, Massachusetts. The Corrective Action Design is being submitted in accordance with the requirements of the Massachusetts Solid Waste Regulations (310 CMR 19.151(2)(a)) in order to obtain approval to remove the SCFA. The BUD application is intended to allow for the use of suitable materials from the SCFA in the site regrading program.

As we have discussed, YAEC is scheduled to initiate removal of the landfill starting in October 2004 in order to meet the overall site closure project schedule. Therefore, we appreciate your timely review and approval of this submittal.
